1.0 CEFNDIR

Paratowyd y Gorchymyn arfaethedig mewn ymateb i amryfal geisiadau gan y Cyngor Cymuned, yr Aelod Lleol a thrigolion Carmel am ostwng y cyfyngiad cyflymder. Ar hyn o bryd, y cyfyngiad cyflymder ar y lôn hon yw'r un cenedlaethol sef 60mya.

Mae copi o'r Rhybudd o Gynnig a'r cynlluniau yn rhoddi manylion am y cyfyngiad arfaethedig ynghlwm.

- 1.1 Yn ystod yr ymgynghori cychwynnol, ni chafwyd yr un gwrthwynebiad i'r Gorchymyn arfaethedig.
- 1.2 Nid yw'r Gwasanaethau Brys wedi gwrthwynebu'r cynnig.
- 1.3 Yn ystod y cyfnod o hysbysebu ffurfiol, derbyniwyd un gwrthwynebiad mewn perthynas â'r B5112 yng Ngharmel (Copi ynghlwm).

Mae'r gwrthwynebiad yn seiliedig ar y rhesymau a ganlyn:-

- (a) Dim angen am y cyfyngiadau cyflymder hyn. Lle mae ardaloedd adeiledig, mae natur droellog y lôn yn golygu bod pobl yn arafu'n awtomatig. Mae

gwelededd yn dda ar y darnau hir clir o'r ffordd ac nid oes unrhyw beryglon mawr.

(b) Y gost fyddai ynghlwm wrth Orchmynion o'r fath o safbwynt gwaith cyfreithiol, swyddfa ac arwyddion.

2.0 Y SEFYLLFA GYFREDOL

- 2.1 Nid yw'r gwrthwynebydd y sonnir amdano yn 1.3 yn fodlon bod y darpariaethau yn y Gorchymyn yn dderbyniol.
- 2.2 Mae'r ffordd wedi cael ei hasesu yn seiliedig ar y meini prawf cyfredol ar gyfer sefydlu Cyfyngiadau Cyflymder yn y Canllawiau a gyhoeddwyd yn Hydref 2009 'Setting Local Speed Limits in Wales'.
- 2.3 Mae cyfyngiad cyflymder o 40mya yn gywir ar y rhan honno o'r ffordd lle mae'r Awdurdod Priffyrdd o'r farn bod modd cyfiawnhau'r cyfyngiad ar sail geometreg y ffordd, lefel y datblygiad a'i defnydd gan ddefnyddwyr bregus oherwydd diffyg cyfleusterau i gerddwyr.
- 2.4 Y cyfraddau gwrthdrawiadau ar hyn o bryd yw 48.7 o wrthdrawiadau fesul miliwn o km cerbydau a chafodd y cyflymder ar gyfartaledd a'r cyflymder ar y 85ain ganradd eu cofnodi fel 33mya a 39mya yn y drefn honno. Argymhellir cyfyngiad cyflymder o 40mya oherwydd bod y rhan hon o'r lôn yn cwrdd â'r gofynion yn seiliedig ar lefel y datblygiad, nifer uchel y troadau neu'r cyffyrdd, lefel uchel o wrthdrawiadau a symudiadau gan ddefnyddwyr ffyrdd bregus.

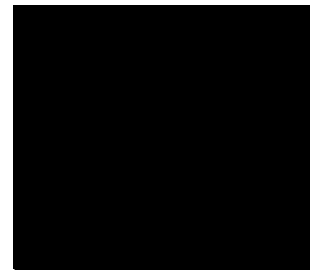
3.0 CASGLIAD

- 3.1 Paratowyd y cyfyngiad arfaethedig mewn ymateb i lefel y pryder cyhoeddus – Cyngor Cymuned Llannerch-y-medd, yr Aelod Lleol a deiseb wedi'i llofnodi gan drigolion Carmel sydd wedi dwyn sylw at eu pryderon ac sy'n cynrychioli lefel y teimlad yn y gymuned leol.
- 3.2 Bydd y gostyngiad arfaethedig yn y cyfyngiad cyflymder yn gwneud y ffyrdd yn ddiogelach i drigolion lleol, cerddwyr a beicwyr.
- 3.3 Bydd y gostyngiad yn y cyfyngiad cyflymder yn gostwng y tebygolrwydd y bydd damwain yn digwydd a difrifoldeb damwain petai yn digwydd.
- 3.4 Cyflwynir y gofynion isaf o safbwynt arwyddion ar gyfer gorfodaeth gyfreithiol ac mae'r Gorchymyn wedi cael ei baratoi ar gyfer ymgynghori yn ei gylch a'i hysbysebu gyda'r cynnig ar gyfer y B5109 yn Nhrefor i ostwng costau.
- 3.5 Mater i'r Pwyllgor fydd penderfynu a ydynt yn teimlo bod modd cyfiawnhau'r gwrthwynebiad ai peidio.

4.0 ARGYMHELLIAD

- 4.1 Bod y Pwyllgor, os ydyw'n fodlon nad yw'r gwrthwynebiadau'n arwyddocaol ac nad ydynt yn adlewyrchiad o'r gefnogaeth gyffredinol, yn cefnogi'r cynnig yn unol â'r Gorchymyn a hysbysebwyd a'r cynlluniau.

Dear Sir,

I would like to register my objection to the introduction of further speed limits along the B5112 (Not that I am expecting the slightest bit of notice will be taken of my remarks as a local resident and driver with around 50 years experience).

My objections are on the following grounds:

1) Necessity.

I can see no requirement for these limits. Where built up areas exist, the twisting nature of the road lends itself to an automatic reduction in speed. The long, clear stretches provide good visibility and do not present any great hazard.

2) Cost.

Having been involved in local government, I am well aware of the enormous cost involved with such orders, in terms of legal and office work plus the cost of signage, etc.

This issue of cost, always important, is particularly crucial at this time. Your authority **should** be working towards all possible means of reducing non-urgent costs – and yet we hear of another substantial increase in Council Tax on the way.

On another aspect, costs could further be reduced by scrapping any further plans for those abominable speed humps which achieve little, other than interrupting emergency services and damaging vehicle suspensions.

RE: PROPOSED SPEED RESTRICTION B5112 CARMEL

Thank you for your letter of the 26th February, 2011 relating to the above mentioned proposal, and I apologise for the delay in replying.

Your comments regarding the proposal are noted, but contrasts starkly with the views of the Community Council, Local Member and those residents of Carmel who have requested speed restrictions in the past. This Order has been prepared in response to complaints received over a number of years regarding excessive speeding in the village. Similarly with traffic calming measures such as speed humps which are only introduced after extensive consultation with local residents and emergency services.

The Authority is mindful of the cost implications of processing traffic regulation Orders, and where possible will combine orders such as the B5112 Carmel and B5109 Trefor to reduce administrative and advertising costs when introducing orders.

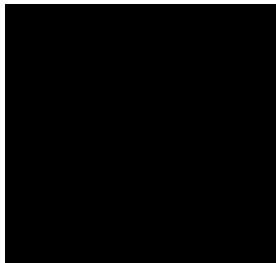
As you are no doubt aware all unresolved objections received during the consultation and advertising stage of a traffic order are reported to the Planning and Orders Committee for their deliberation. To date I have only received one recorded objection to the B5112 proposal.

Many thanks for your reply to my letter of objection (26/2/11).

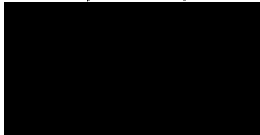
I do understand your comments regarding feedback which your department has received from the local member & Com. Council, but in regard to this I would point out that it is only those with a grouse who normally raise issues with Councillors. I would suggest that the silent (and content) residents probably outweigh those who complain about alleged speeding.

I make this point with some knowledge of the matter, having served many years as a Councillor at Parish & District level. I have never experienced a resident contacting me to say that they were *happy* with the status quo!

Frankly, the reason for my objection is not the speed limit per se – I doubt it will make the slightest difference, given the self-regulating nature of the road. What does concern me is that trivial but expensive items such as this are wasting your valuable resources and I believe that your energy and available cash could be better spent on for example, highway repairs and improvement. In this respect I commend your department for doing a good job.

To answer your final paragraph – I would be grateful if this could be carried forward to the committee stage, as the points I raise are I believe, fair and a matter of concern.

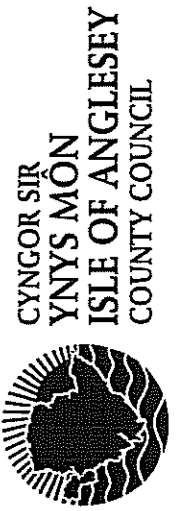
