As a Local Member I, along with Councillors John Griffith and Ken Hughes, attend the 7 Community Council meetings on a rota basis. I am also a Governor at Llanfechell Primary School and at Bodedern Secondary School where I am currently the Chair. I represent the Talybolion electorate on a number of different local matters such as Housing, Planning, Waste, Highways, Social Services matters etc.

I work with a number of community groups namely Ffrindiau Bodedern, Ffrindiau Llanfachtraeth which was established this year with my support and I support a group that is just starting out in Llanfaethlu in order to improve the playground facility in the village. I have been able to bring in the support of Menter Môn and Medrwn Môn when needed in order to support the community activities.

During the challenging Covid period I have continued to maintain contact with the communities whilst leading the Council in a crisis. I have met regularly with the Welsh Government, Public Health Wales and Betsi Cadwaladr Health Board so as to ensure that Anglesey has a strong voice during the crisis.
