#### 2 - Constituency Activity

I have assisted constituents with a number of issues relating to services offered by the Council. Examples include making enquiries with the housing department about repair work, calling in applications to the Planning Committee and speaking on behalf of applicants or opponents, trying to explain the Local Development Plan to applicants, putting pressure on the Highways department (in conjunction with all members of the Community Council) to place a crossing between the Co-op and the new flats on the site of the former Glanrafon Hotel. Helping to interpret housing legislation with regard to the second homes premium, when a dwelling has been purpose built as a holiday home.

### 3 - Initiatives and Special Activities

Alongside the local Community Council, I have (since I was first elected in 2008) worked with the Highways Department to try to find a solution that will ease traffic problems on the square during at the height of the holiday season. A survey has been undertaken recently and we are currently awaiting the results. It is extremely difficult to find a solution that will please everyone due to the complex nature of the crossroads on the square. It has seven access points, not four, and the road isn't big enough to accommodate a roundabout.

I am also a member of the local Community Council and this year we have been doing more voluntary work around the village. We have been cleaning the bus stops and road signs, we are in the process of repainting the old black and white road sign column on the square and we will be locating flower planters around the village in the future.
