Role & Responsibilities

During the last year I was elected Chair of the County Council, a post I had previously held in 2011/12. It was a very busy year for me as the Island's Principal Citizen and I had the privilege of attending a number of events on the Island and beyond. I had the opportunity to meet many people in various events and ceremonies. Three major civic events were held during the year, the Freedom of the Island Ceremony for the Royal Air Force during June in Llangefni, the Chairman's Sunday in Tabor Chapel, Valley and then the Chairman's Charity Dinner in the Trearddur Bay Hotel at the end of my term as Chair. During the year, £6,150 was collected for 3 organisations, i.e. Dewi Ward, which is the Children's Ward in Ysbyty Gwynedd; Coronary Care Fund Ysbyty Gwynedd and Anglesey Crossroads.
