## 1 - Role & Responsibilities

I act as one of two councillors for the Llifon Ward.

During the year I was appointed a member of the Children's Services Transformation Board and to serve on a Working Group responding to the proposals of the Williams Commission Report on Local Government Reorganisation.

I served as a member of many committees as shown below, and attended briefing and training sessions.
