I am a member of the Anglesey Schools Progress Group which is trying to improve the understanding of Elected Members of the challenges facing the Authority's schools.

I attend the Wylfa Newydd Project Liaison Group.

I attended Morning Service in Ysgol Pencarnisiog as part of my responsibilities as a member of the Standing Advisory Council on Religious Education.

As Vice-Chairman of the Corporate Scrutiny Committee, I chaired a panel which looked at the delay with regard to letting Council Houses in the Authority.

I was a member of a Panel which met on a monthly basis to discuss the implications of the new Social Services and Wellbeing Act.

I also attended meetings with local residents who live on the Cymyran road in an attempt to alleviate their concerns with regard to road safety in light of the heavy lorries that would be using this rural road.

I attend Rhosneigr Village Hall every Saturday morning the local library on Wednesday afternoons in order to discuss various issues.

I am a member of the Llanfair yn Neubwll Community Council and attend meetings of the Llanfaelog and Valley Councils monthly as an observer.

I am a member of the Governing Body of Bodedern Secondary School and the Governing Body's Staffing Committee. I am also a member of the Governing Body of Valley School.

I was a member of two appeal committees for the Wales National Eisteddfod 2017 in Valley and Llanynghenedl and Pencarnisiog. We managed to reach the funding target in both areas.
