Dear Licensing Committee,

I am writing to formally object to the premises licence application for Hafan Shop Ltd, 5-7 High St, Llangefni. As a local resident I believe that granting this licence will negatively impact the licence objectives of preventing public nuisance and protecting children from harm.

The proposed operating hours until 23.00 daily will increase foot traffic and loitering late into the evening, disturbing families living nearby.

Late night off-sales frequently lead to increased street drinking and anti-social behaviour as well as increased littering. There is already a 'Spar' Shop directly opposite these premises off-selling alcohol, surely this is enough for the size of Llangefni High Street.

The Hafan Shop premises is located on a small high street, frequented by children and close to a public park 'The Dingle' where children gather. There is a risk here of adults purchasing alcohol on behalf of minors. As the Committee and Council , are well aware, there is already a problem with street/park drinking by adults and children in Llangefni Town, and granting the application will only worsen the situation.

For these reasons I urge the Council / Committee to refuse this application.

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Good morning,

I believe the white shop has applied for an alcohol licence.

Could I please offer my reasons as to why I don't think this should be allowed.

It is well known that the white shop has been selling illegal vapes, illegal cigarettes and vapes to under 18's. I can say with a certain amount of surety that they WILL sell alcohol outside of the hours allowed, and they will sell illegal alcohol and also to minors.

We already have issues in town with alcohol abuse and this will just fuel it.

We have Siop Ellis Spar, Asda, Iceland, Home bargains, B&M , the Spar opposite the white shop – and various pubs. This is enough for the town.

All of the above mentioned are responsible sellers. If someone is clearly intoxicated – they will not sell them alcohol.

I do not believe that the white shop would do this, and I think they would sell regardless.

I can see exactly what will happen – last orders and the pubs are kicking everyone out : the first thing they will do is go to the white shop and get more cans to walk home with.

This is going to increase anti social behaviour and littering, and this will all be going on late evening.

Unless there is going to be an increased Presence of Police officers in town, this application should not be granted.

You will see from the logs that the shops in town have submitted an email showing the increased levels of anti social behaviour in town, mainly fuelled from alcohol.

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Dear Licensing Authority,

I am writing to formally lodge my objection to the application for a new licence to sell alcohol at 7-9 High Street, situated in Llangefni town centre.

My objection is made on the grounds of two key licensing objectives: The Prevention of Crime and Disorder and The Prevention of Public Nuisance.

As recently highlighted in public updates on social media by North Wales Police Anglesey, Llangefni town centre is currently facing significant issues with anti-social behaviour (ASB). The police have openly communicated with residents and local businesses regarding their ongoing efforts to tackle street disorder, nuisance, and alcohol-related incidents in the area.

Granting another licence to sell alcohol in the very heart of the town centre completely contradicts these efforts and is the wrong decision for our community at this time. Increasing the availability of alcohol in an area already identified as an ASB hotspot will only:

- Exacerbate public nuisance and street drinking in shared town centre spaces.
- Undermine active police interventions aimed at curbing disorder and making the town safe for residents and visitors.
- Heighten risks around proxy purchasing and youth nuisance, worsening alcohol-fuelled disorder in local public areas.

At a time when local law enforcement is openly raising concerns about ASB in Llangefni, granting a new alcohol licence sends the wrong message and directly threatens community safety. I strongly urge the Licensing Committee to refuse this application.
